Refund Rules	Refund permitted before departure (travel date from BRU). Fare rule refund penalties and restrictions waived.

Ancillaries	Refund of unused ancillaries associated with refunded coupons is permitted.	

Handling instructions for travel agents:

- Travel agents may not use automated refund tools (e.g. Amadeus Ticket Changer, NDC TrueReshop, Travelport Rapid Reprice, etc.). Manual processes apply.
- Waiver not required provided TWP conditions are fulfilled.
- You can do the **refund for unused tickets** in accordance with this Ticketing Waiver Policy (TWP 2509) and entry of the waiver code without having to request a waiver from your Lufthansa Group Agency Support.
- Partially used tickets: Please raise refund application via BSP or other local processes (in non-BSP markets).
- All transactions are subject to audit. Non-compliance with TWP rules will result in an Agent Debit Memo (ADM).

Endorsement Box:

Travel Agents must enter: "TWP2509" followed by the FE box original entries.

Example: TWP2509 FARE RESTRICTIONS MAY APPLY

Refund mask:

Mandatory entry of "TWP2509" in waiver field / airline authority box of the refund mask.

- Amadeus: TRFU/WA TWP2509
- Farelogix-SPRK: Enter "TWP2509" in the Refund window / Waiver code box
- Galileo/Travelport: Start direct refund via TRNE entry. Enter "TWP2509" in the waiver box (A/L authority).
- Sabre: After direct refund "WFR" entry, enter "TWP2509" in the waiver box
- Infini: Enter "TWP2509" under Refunds Reason Code
